


## 24 Volt Heated Rails- How to reduce the Temperature

If you feel that your rails are too hot, it is possible to dial the temperature down as follows:

The transformer used in conjunction with your installed rail(s) has a voltage adjustment that should be dialed down to reduce the rail temperature by up to 25%.

This transformer could be located inside the ceiling cavity, inside your vanity or similar location. The installation instructions guides for a "ventilated, accessible location".



## Adjustment Procedure

- At the back of the transformer you will find 2 rubber plugs
- Remove the one labeled "Vo ADJ" as shown above
- Using a small flat or phillips screwdriver adjust setting to minimum (Turn anticlockwise all the way)
- Replace the rubber plug

There is no electrical danger in making this adjustment, however if you feel uncomfortable doing this then call Avenir or your electrician for assistance.
