VITREOUS STONEWARE TERRA

PLUMBLINE



Locally produced from Vitreous Stoneware, the Terra basin's strong, sculpted form is enriched by four hand-applied glazes—each a tribute to the rich textures and tones of Aotearoa's natural landscape. This stoneware offers a strong barrier against daily wear, ensuring longevity for years to come. Despite its resilience, like any material, proper care is essential to maintain its pristine appearance and prevent the accumulation of limescale, calcium deposits, and soap scum.

Daily cleaning

Vitreous Stoneware requires minimal maintenance on a daily basis. However, any spills of acidic substances, such as citrus-based products or nail polish remover, should not be left on the surface for long periods of time. To prevent limescale and calcium build-up, dry the basin/vanity top after use when possible.

Weekly/monthly cleaning

For periodic cleaning a mild cleaner such as an antibacterial bathroom cleaner or liquid dishsoap with water can be used with a microfibre cloth.

Removing harsh marks

Neglecting routine cleaning may result in tough residues from hard water, toothpaste, and other bathroom products. Mild abrasive cleaners such as Bar Keepers Friend or Ajax Cream Cleanser can effectively remove such build-up. These products are readily available at local supermarkets or hardware stores. When using abrasive cleaners, take care to avoid damaging the finish of your tapware or waste.

Avoid using steel wool and heavy-duty scouring pads, as they can scratch the surface.
